National Volunteer Week runs from Monday 15 to Sunday 21 May. You may be interested to know that during 2021/2022, there were 6018 volunteers in the Shire. During this period, 250,000 hours were contributed by the Volunteer Bushfire Brigades. A further 6903 total annual hours across the Shire's libraries, Visitor Centre, and Hub of the Hills, Thank you to all of our volunteers for your dedication and service to making our community a better
