

Linemarking Requirements

Sporting Clubs, Associations & Casual Users

1. **Sporting Clubs or Associations** – Line marking of Shire of Mundaring reserves by sporting clubs are to be as follows:
 - a) The only substance permissible for line marking on Shire of Mundaring Reserves is water based paint that is registered for line marking use.
 - b) As many applications of water based registered line marking paint may be applied as necessary throughout the season. The final applications are to be no later than 2 matches prior to the season changeover date.
 - c) The use of Roundup/Glyphosate Herbicide, Creosote, Diesel, Lime or any other substance that damages turf grass is not permissible for line marking Shire of Mundaring Reserves.
 - d) Any club found to have breached Shire of Mundaring line marking requirements is liable to be held financially responsible for the repair to damage caused by inappropriate use of banned substances.
 - e) In special cases, an offending club will be requested to pay a bond prior to its seasonal allocation being approved.
2. **Casual Users ie Schools/Festival Events** – Line markings made on Shire Reserves by organisations are to be as follows.
 - a) The only substance permissible for line marking on Shire of Mundaring Reserves is registered line marking water based paint.
 - b) Applications of water based line marking paint may be applied as necessary; however markings should not interfere with a resident sporting club's regular ongoing use of the reserve.
 - c) The use of Roundup/Glyphosate Herbicide, Creosote, Diesel, Lime or any other substance that damages Turf Grass is not permissible for line marking Shire Reserves.
 - d) Any user found to have breached the Shire of Mundaring line marking requirements is liable to be held financially responsible for the repair to damage caused by inappropriate use of banned substances.
