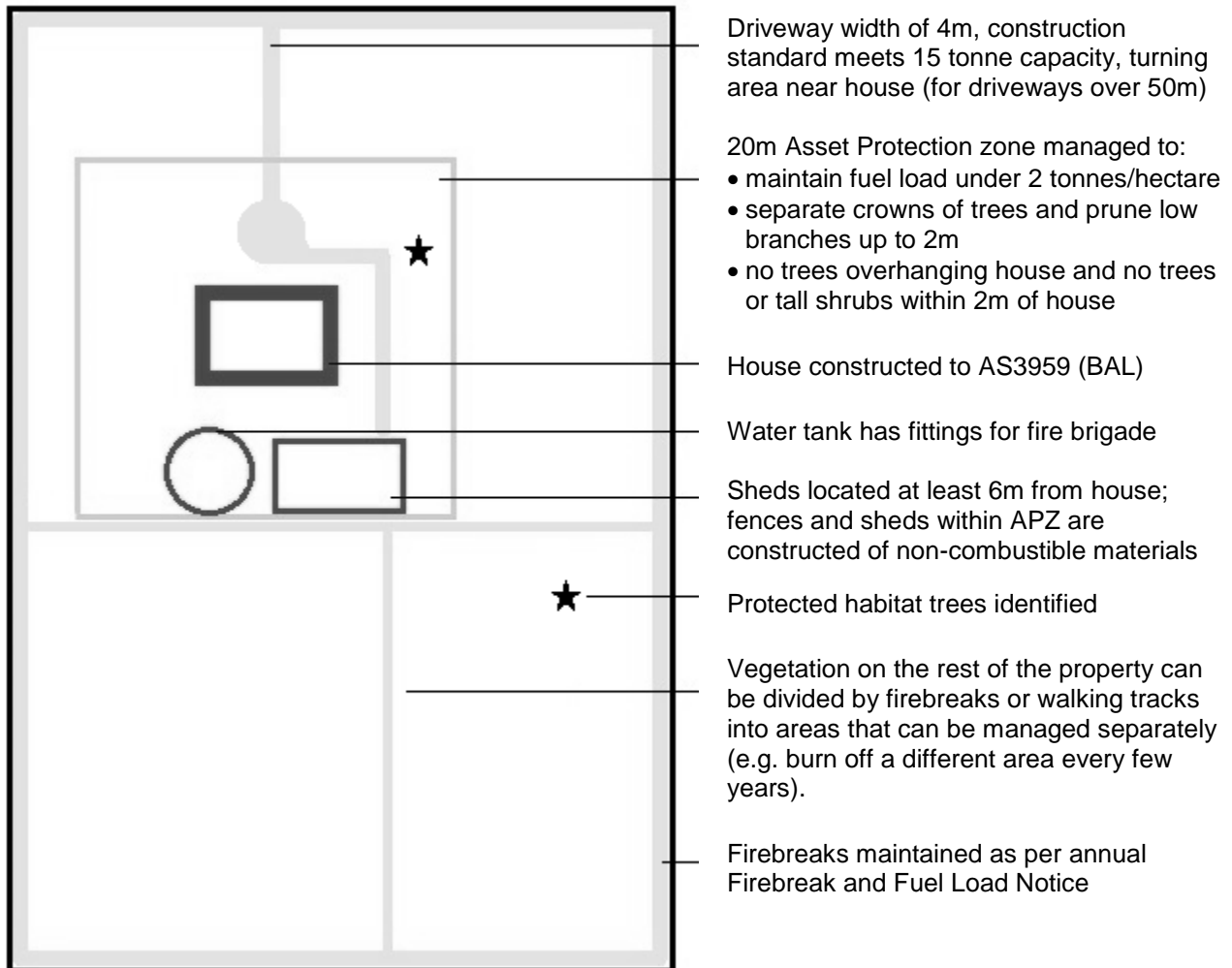


## Bushfire Management Statement

This A3 summary page demonstrates how the proposed development can and will comply with relevant criteria of the *WA Guidelines for Planning in Bushfire Prone Areas*. Where a Bushfire Management Plan applies to the area this should be specifically referenced.

There must be a labelled site plan showing habitable buildings, the APZ, and bushfire risk management, eg below.

There will be a table addressing each of the elements in Appendix Four of the Guidelines and listing the relevant information and ongoing actions for this property.

The Bushfire Management Statement should also include the name, credentials and company of the bushfire consultant who prepared it, and leave space for the Shire of Mundaring planning approval stamp.
