

Lake Leschenaultia All-Terrain Wheelchair Conditions of Use and User Agreement

Please note the design of the lake's all-terrain wheelchair may not be able to accommodate the needs of every person with mobility issues. It is important for each prospective user and/or carer to assess its suitability before use.

To ensure the safety of patrons who choose to use the lake's all-terrain wheelchair, Shire of Mundaring places conditions on its use. Acknowledgement and agreement of these conditions is required prior to its use.

The all-terrain wheelchair must:

- Always have someone pushing/holding the chair when it is occupied;
- Not be used by a person over 120kg;
- Not be used on the beach sand unless the person in the wheelchair weighs less than 50kg;
- Not be taken into the water; and
- Be treated with care and consideration.

Users and/or their carers must also agree to do the following:

- Engage the braking system **BEFORE** the person enters the chair;
- Dis-engage the brakes **BEFORE** moving; and
- Not attempt to apply the brakes **WHEN MOVING** or on a slope.

Please note, failure to do any of the above could result in an accident, injury and/or damage to the wheels and/or brake pins.
