



Restoring Broz Park Wetland Helena Valley

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Broz Park wetland is the focus of an environmental restoration project being undertaken by Shire of Mundaring during 2020 and 2021.

This project aims to improve the water quality and ecosystem functioning of this wetland by:

- removing non-native fish species
- installing an artificial water aeration system
- revegetating the banks of the wetland to filter nutrients and provide fauna habitat
- introducing native fish species into the wetland
- educating the community about healthy wildlife interactions and
- increasing community awareness of the impacts of fertiliser use on wetlands and waterways.
