Project Update - Mundaring Multi-Purpose Community Facility

A significant milestone was achieved as Council recently endorsed a preferred design concept and masterplan for the Multi-Purpose Community Facility (MPCF) and surrounding Cultural Precinct, including:

- the general form, layout and siting for the MPCF;
- the services to be accommodated in the proposed facility; and
 - proposed upgrades to enhance the surrounding precinct.

Notably, Council acknowledged the invaluable contributions of the community and key stakeholders in the development of the presented concept sketch and masterplan options.

Looking forward, the Shire will embark on operational modeling, initiate a developed concept design, seek external funding sources, advance land assembly negotiations and commence initial place-making initiatives.
