Parenting Workshops

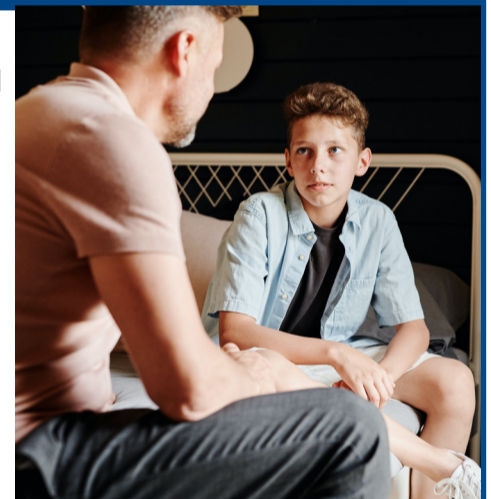
Midvale Hub Parenting Service is presenting the following FREE parenting program in February and March.
